Acorn's toddler camp is for children independently walking to 36 months of age who attended Acorn during the 2022-2023 school year or who are enrolled in our toddler program for September 2023. Our youngest campers enjoy lots of fun and water activities in their own outdoor environment. Toddlers who have been enrolled in Acorn continue to follow their familiar daily schedule, started during the school year, which allows them to be secure and independent in their own movement and choices. Campers bring their own nut-free lunch to eat outside at picnic tables during nice weather. Should it rain or get too hot, they will eat inside in the air conditioned classroom.

We can accept late enrollment, pending availability, up until the Monday prior to the start of the camp week.

All enrollment paperwork, including updated medical records, is due with registration.

All camp fees are payable in advance with registration.

Each change made after the initial registration has been processed, with the exception of adding additional weeks, shall incur a \$10 processing fee.

There will be a charge of \$55 for each instance of insufficient funds or declined credit.
